Walk

Bike



Avion Burbank has 7 on-site bike parking locations noted by the bike icons on the site directory.

The Burbank Airport North Metrolink Station has 6 bicycle lockers available for rent. The lockers are free to use; registration is required. To register, contact the City of Burbank at nburant@burbankca.gov or (818) 238-5290.

TAP App



Fare for Metro Bus and Rail is \$1.75 and \$1 for BurbankBus. Purchase your TAP card to ride at TAPtoGo.net or in person at any Metro rail station.

The [TAP app](#) is also now available for both Android and iPhone smartphones. Use the app to add, manage, and reload your TAP card balance and to use your phone for contactless payments. The TAP app is compatible everywhere you use your TAP card. That includes Metro Bus and Rail, and [other agencies across LA County](#). Download from [Google Play](#) and the [App Store](#).
