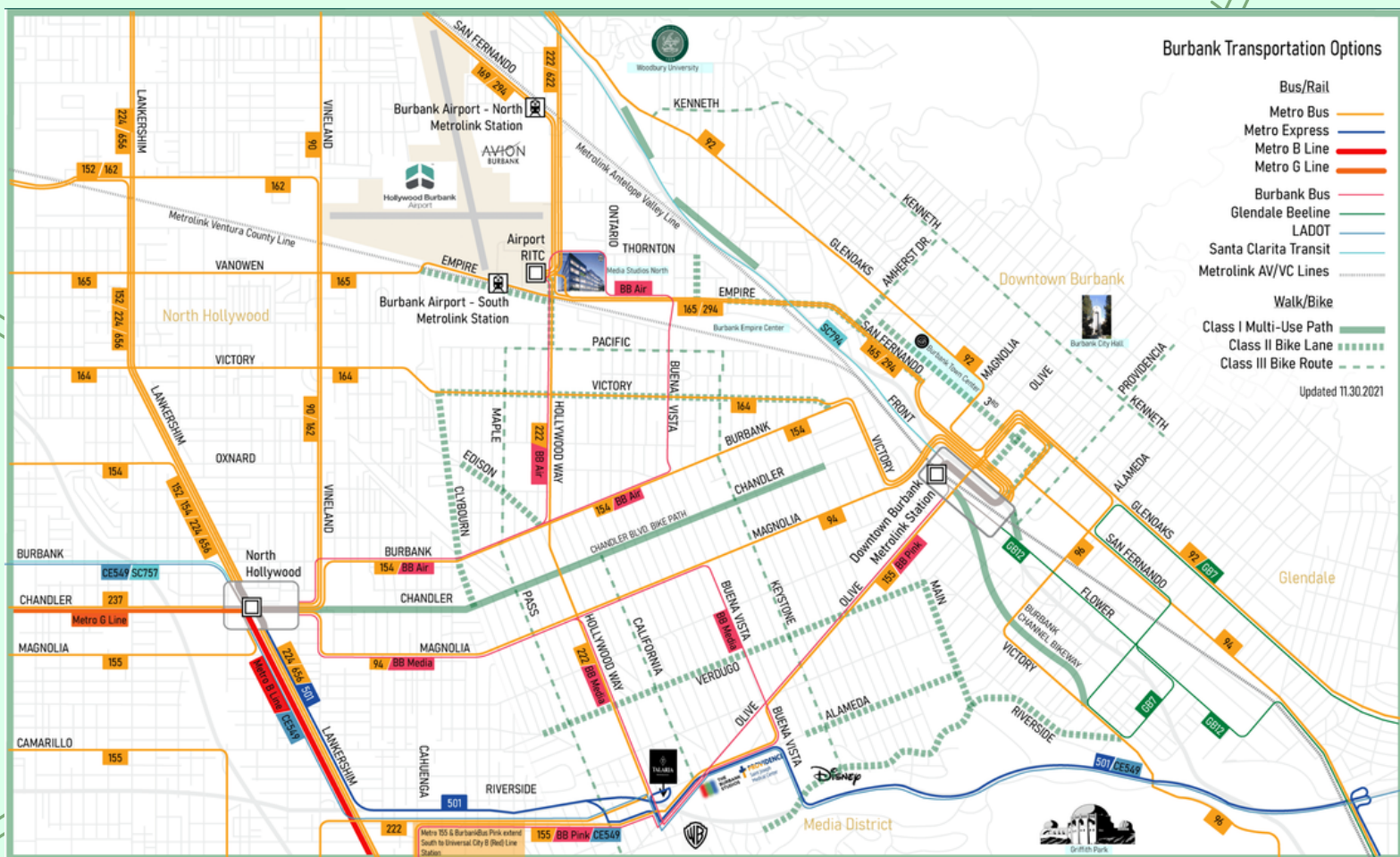


BTMO COMMUTE OPTIONS

Bicycle
