


Voters approved Measure HLA. Now the city needs to agree on a plan

"L.A. voters last year decided that the city must carry out street improvements that prioritize cyclists, pedestrians and transit. But the city has yet to decide how it wants to implement Measure HLA's mandate..."

Around a decade ago, the city approved Mobility Plan 2035. The plan specifies networks of streets where the city wants to make upgrades, like protected bike lanes, enhanced bus stop shelters and wider sidewalks..."

"The Mobility Plan is just that: It's a plan," said Eli Lipmen, the executive director of Move LA, which endorsed the initiative. "It's a vision for where we can go, but there's no actual path to get us to achieve that. That's really what we tried to drive home with 'Yes' on Measure HLA."

Transitioning to Renewable Energy: A Complex Path for Burbank's Future





"Under California state law, Burbank Water and Power is required to have an energy portfolio of 60% renewables by 2030 and be 100% zero carbon by 2045. Switching to renewable energy sources is not as simple as flipping a switch. It is a multifaceted process that requires careful planning, complex contract negotiations with third parties, logistical hurdles such as new infrastructure requirements both in and outside of Burbank, and significant financial investment. As BWP embarks on this journey, residents can expect changes that will ultimately shape the city's energy landscape—and, by extension, their energy bills."
