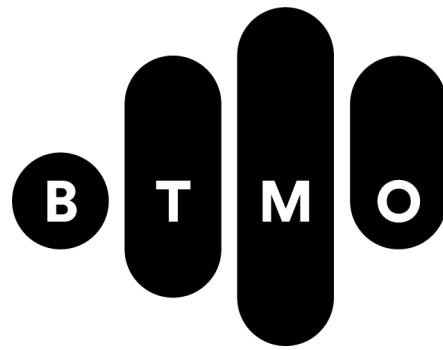

New Plan Aims to Make Burbank Streets Fatality-Free by 2035

"The effort, detailed in a comprehensive report released this week, outlines a sweeping set of changes aimed at reducing collisions, lowering vehicle speeds and redesigning roads to protect the city's most vulnerable travelers.

Dubbed the Safer Streets Burbank plan, city planners gave a first look of the report to transportation commissioners on Wednesday, July 23, and the City Council will weigh in on Aug. 12."

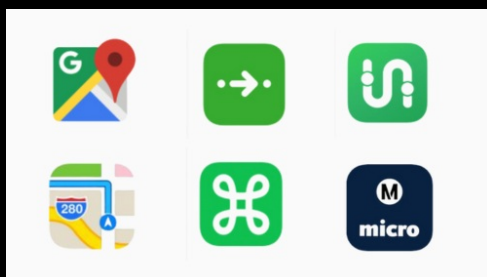
"An organizer who led a group of residents to paint a set of crosswalks around a popular West L.A. park says he's not giving up after the city scrubbed away their creations on Friday.
