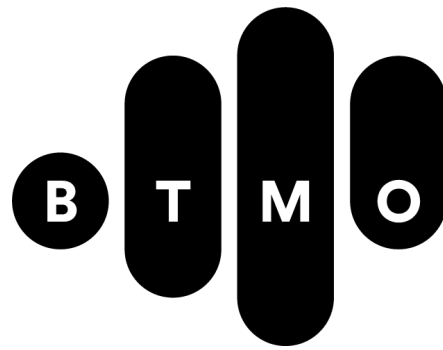

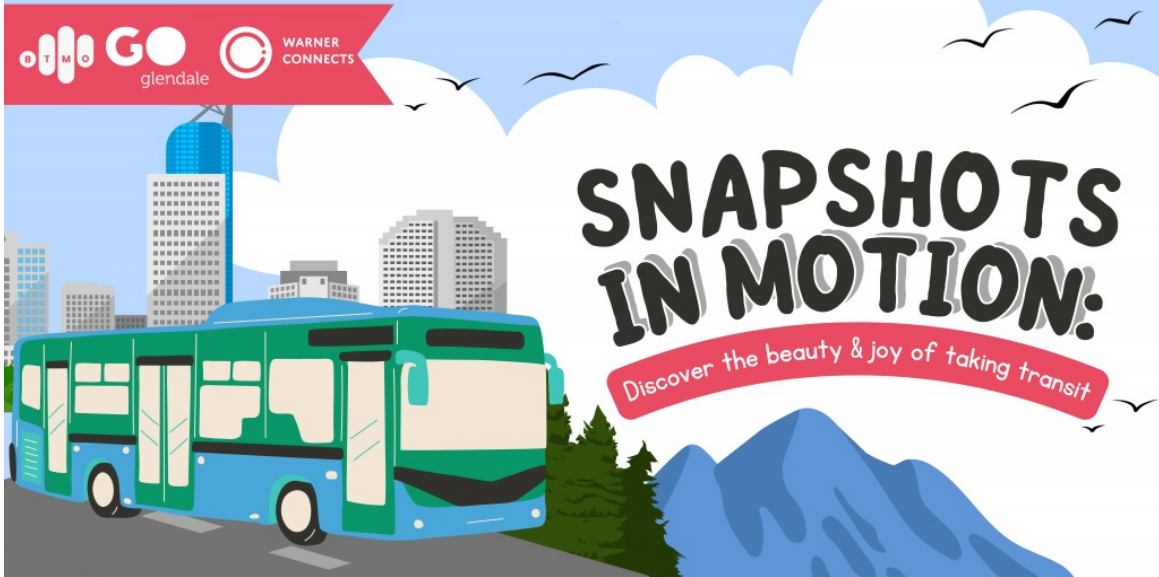

Why Survey?

Each year, employers in the Media District and Downtown Burbank with 25 or more employees are required to survey their employees to determine their Average Vehicle Ridership (AVR) scores and report their efforts to reduce employee trips in Burbank.

These surveys are vital for tracking progress and understanding Burbank's transportation needs, contributing to a less congested and more sustainable community.

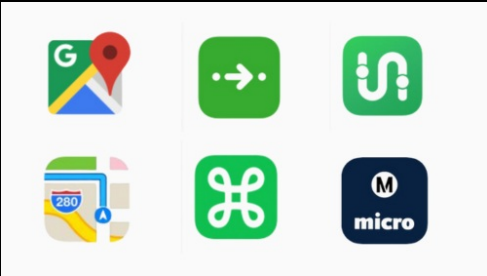

"We're still asking. I don't know if we're gonna get the whole \$3.2 [billion]. A lot of what we need is to lease extra buses. We're gonna lease close to 3,000 buses, which also means we need to lease the drivers of the buses, which means we need to figure out where they're gonna stay and live, and the training that they're gonna need to navigate our streets in L.A. County because the Olympics venues are all over. They're not just in the

city of L.A. So that's a big undertaking."
