Burbank will kick off this holiday season with their free Holiday Street Fair on November 22. Holiday vendors, non-profit organizations, and live entertainment will be on San Fernando Blvd. from 12 to 8 p.m.


Plus, you can skip the parking hassle with Metrolink! Take the **Antelope Valley (AV) or Ventura County (VC) lines and exit at the Burbank-Downtown station**. From the station, **walk 13 mins.** (approx. .06 miles) to North San Fernando Blvd. **or take a Metro Micro shuttle** by booking through <u>book.metro-micro.net</u> and use your TAP card.

Metrolink offers a \$10 Weekend Day Pass that can be used for unlimited rides on weekends, and kids 17 and under ride for free when accompanied by a fare-paying adult. Tickets should be purchased at Metrolink ticket machines or on the Metrolink app on the day of travel.

LAX Terminal 5 is getting torn down for rebuild before Olympics. What travelers need to know

Terminal 5 at Los Angeles International Airport will be torn down Tuesday for an overhaul ahead of the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games. Passengers and flights using T5 will be rerouted through other terminals and the newly opened Midfield Satellite Concourse South (MSC South) — a 150,000-square-foot extension of the West Gates at Tom Bradley International Terminal equipped with eight new gates.

Uber's autonomous fleet to launch in San Francisco and expand to 20,000 vehicles






Uber said the San Francisco Bay Area will be the first market for its specially built autonomous taxi, which is expected to launch in late 2026. The company previously said it was developing a robotaxi with the electric car company Lucid and the self-driving technology company Nuro Inc. The vehicle will be exclusive to Uber but is based on the Lucid Gravity SUV. There are plans to have 100 test vehicles on the road in the coming months.
