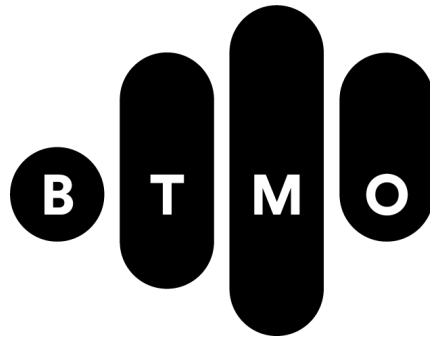

The City of Burbank Parks and Recreation Department launched their trail accessibility program on January 31st, helping to create more inclusive access to public open spaces. The program introduces an all-terrain Action Trackchair AXIS 40 to provide equitable, safe, and dignified access to the Stough Canyon Fire Trail for people of all abilities. The Trackchair is specifically designed for rugged environments, allowing users to navigate the trail with ease while maintaining safety and visibility alongside other trail users

New Access Points Being Added to Chandler Path



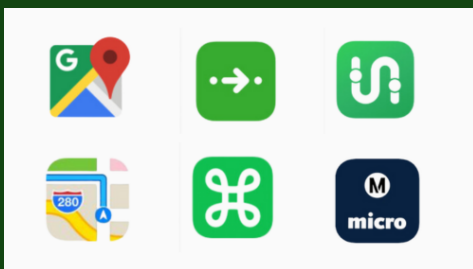

The 2.5 mile Burbank-Chandler bike/walk path that runs through Burbank and Los Angeles is currently going through some major changes to address accessibility concerns. Over the past few years, the city of L.A. has been addressing the L.A. section of the path and the informal access present to the south.

The city of L.A. has already added several official access points to the south, including the completion of new wheelchair-accessible ramps at Satsuma Avenue and Cartwright Avenue. Phase 2 of the project is currently in progress, which looks to bring a third access point to Strohm Avenue and to improve accessibility and connectivity along the path.
