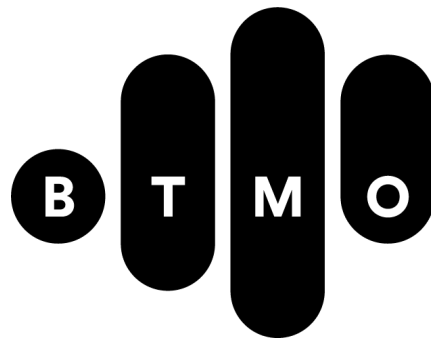

FIFA Fan Zone for the Final! Take Transit.

Date & Time: Saturday, July 18 from 12 to 8 p.m. & Sunday, July 19 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Don't miss kickoff! It is strongly encouraged to utilize local transit to get to the event:

- **Metrolink: Via the Downtown Burbank Station** on the Antelope Valley and Ventura County Lines. The Fan Zone is a **short walk or free shuttle ride** from the station. Use the [Metrolink SoCal Day Pass](#) for unlimited travel throughout the day.
- **Free BurbankBus shuttle:** Will operate between **Universal City/Studio City Station and the Fan Zone** approximately every 15 minutes.
 - Metro B Line riders can connect via Universal City/Studio City Station.
- **Metro Bus: Multiple routes serve Downtown Burbank**, including **Lines 92, 94, 154, 155, 164, 165, 294, and 296**.

The event is expected to attract significant attendance – **please prepare for traffic and pedestrian congestion and commute delays** in and around the Burbank region. You can expect:

- Significant traffic congestion near **San Fernando Blvd., Magnolia Blvd., Angeleno Ave., Olive Ave., and adjacent Downtown streets**
- Increased traffic on regional routes serving Burbank, including **I-5, SR-134, SR-170, and US-101 connections**
- Increased demand and **crowding on Metrolink, Metro Bus, and BurbankBus services**
- **Longer travel times throughout the region**

If you are planning on traveling during the event, here are a few tips:

- Allow for additional time
- Avoid driving, if possible, especially near Downtown Burbank. Consider alternatives to driving; view transit options [here](#).
- Monitor traffic and transit conditions before traveling

Metro Ridership Jumps 9% from June 2025

More people are choosing transit across Los Angeles. Metro recorded 26.3 million rides in June, a 9% increase from the previous year, driven by major events, expanded rail service, and improved connections throughout the region. Bus ridership grew nearly 7%, while rail ridership increased nearly 22% year-over-year.

The growth was fueled by events such as World Cup festivities, LA Pride celebrations, concerts, and the opening of new D Line Extension stations, making it easier for riders to reach destinations across LA County.

Progress on Chandler Center-Running Bike Lanes

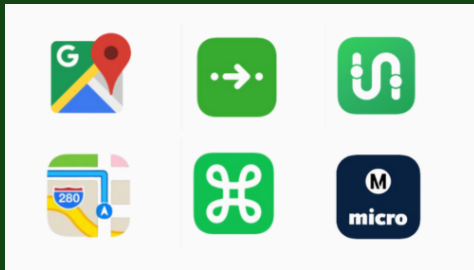
Construction is progressing on the Chandler Bicycle Connection Project, a \$7 million initiative that will upgrade approximately three miles of bike lanes between the North Hollywood Metro Station and Coldwater Canyon Avenue. The project relocates existing

bike lanes to a center-running design along the boulevard median, improving connections along the Metro G Line corridor while minimizing impacts to on-street parking.

Planned improvements include new protected bike lanes, upgraded pedestrian infrastructure, accessibility enhancements, transit platform improvements, and traffic signal modifications. Once complete, the project will provide a safer and more comfortable biking experience for riders traveling through the San Fernando Valley.
