WALK

TRAIN

Metrolink has 3 stations in Burbank: Downtown Burbank, Burbank Airport-North, and Burbank Airport-South. Visit metrolinktrains.com to access all of Southern California. **Metro B** Line connects Downtown LA to the Universal City station. Transfer to Metro or BurbankBus from there.
